finished measurements

Approximately 8" wide x 70" long
(not including fringe)

materials

3 balls each **BERROCO COTOLANA**
(50 grs), #3515 Madder (MC), #3506
Sycamore (CC1) and #3524 Cypress
(CC2) – CC2 is for fringe only.

Straight knitting needles, size 13
(9.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN
GAUGE

Crochet hook, size 6.00 mm (J)

gauge

9 sts and 14 rows = 4" in k1, p1
ribbing with MC and CC1 held
together (unstretched)

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK
GAUGE

NOTE

1 strand each of MC and CC1 are worked together throughout.

SCARF

With 1 strand each of MC and CC1, cast on 35 sts.

Row 1 (WS): K2, * p1, k1, rep from * to last st, end k1.

Row 2 (RS): K3, * p1, k1, rep from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 70" from beg, end with a WS row. Bind off loosely in pat.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends and block as desired.

Fringe: Cut five 12" long strands of CC2. Put strands together and fold in half. Using crochet hook, draw center of strands through the 2nd st of cast-on edge of scarf forming a loop. Pull ends of strands through this loop, forming fringe. In this manner, make fringe evenly spaced approximately 1" apart across both cast-on and bound-off edges of scarf. Trim to even off if necessary.
