## **Edition 3 Hat Knitting Pattern**

#### You will need:

- 1 ball <u>Schoppel-Wolle Edition 3</u> <u>Yarn</u>, shown in 2296
- Size <u>US 7 circular 16" needles</u>
- Size <u>US 7 double pointed needles</u>
- <u>Stitch marker</u>
- <u>Tapestry needle</u>

Measures: 18" circumference x 8.25" high Gauge: 21 sts to 4" in st st

## Hat Pattern

Cast on 96 stitches. Join ends being careful not to twist yarn and place marker

Rounds 1 - 5: \*K2, p2.\* Repeat from \* to \* around to create ribbed edge. Next, work in stockinette stitch (k every row) until hat measures 7" from the beginning.

Switch to double pointed needles and work hat shaping as follows: Round 1: \*K6 sts, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 84 sts.

Round 2: Knit Round 3: \*K5 sts, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 72 sts. Round 4: Knit

Round 5: \*K4 sts, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 60 sts. Round 6: Knit

Round 7: \*K3 sts, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 48 sts.

Round 8: \*K2 sts, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 36 sts.

Round 9: \*K1 st, k2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 24 sts.

Round 9: \*K2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 12 sts.

Round 10: \*K2tog.\* Repeat from \* to \* around - 6 sts.







Cut yarn leaving approximately an 8" tail. Using a yarn needle, weave tail through remaining 6 sts then remove them from the needles. Fasten, weave in yarn ends.

# Abbreviations

K: knit
K2tog: knit two stitches together (decrease)
St(s) Stitch(es)
