## Islamorada Shawl

## SIZE

6।" wingspan, 26.5" deep

MATERIALS
Manos del Uruguay ALEGRIA (75\% superwash merino, 25\% polyamide; approx. 445 yds/l00g); I skein each Colors A, B, C, \& D. Shown in A2058
Turmeric (A), A2363 Tahiti (B), A2394 Teal (C) and A2293 Leo (D).

US $5 / 3.75 \mathrm{~mm}$ needles, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN
GAUGE
Tapestry needle

## GAUGE

20 sts and 36 rows $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in Stockinette stitch, blocked.

## NOTES

Each section uses 50 g of each color. Feel free to weigh your skein, wind it, and then measure what's left in your ball as you knit to determine where to stop each section. If you choose to work sections by yarn amount please remember that your stitch count will be different than what is written in the pattern.


## ABBREVIATIONS

inc('d): increase(d)
k: knit
mll: pick up the bar between the last stitch you just worked and the one you're about to work, bringing the needle from front to back; knit into the back of this stitch. [I st inc'd] mIR: pick up the bar between the last stitch you just worked and the one you're about to work, bringing the needle from the back to the front; knit into the front of this stitch. [I st inc'd] m I Lbf: pick up the bar between the last stitch you just worked and the one you're about to work, bringing the needle from front to back; knit into the back of this stitch, and then the front. [2 sts inc'd]
mIRfb: pick up the bar between the last stitch you just worked and the one you're about to work, bringing the needle from the back to the front; knit into the front of this stitch, and then the back. [2 sts inc'd]
pm: place marker
RS: right side
sl: slip
slm: slip marker
st(s): stitch(es)
WS: wrong side


STITCH GUIDE
Stockinette Increase Pattern
Row I (RS): K5, mIR, k to m, mIL, slm, kI, slm, $\mathrm{mIR}, \mathrm{k}$ to last $5 \mathrm{sts}, \mathrm{m} \mid \mathrm{L}, \mathrm{k} 5$. [4 sts inc'd]
Row 2 (WS): K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Garter Increase Pattern
Row I (RS): K5, m I R, k to m, m I L, slm, kI, slm, $\mathrm{m} \mid \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{k}$ to last $5 \mathrm{sts}, \mathrm{m} / \mathrm{L}, \mathrm{k} 5$. [4 sts inc'd]
Row 2 (WS): Knit.

INSTRUCTIONS
With Color A, cast on 3 sts.

Set-up Row 0 (WS): K3.
Set-up Row I (RS): KI, m I Rfb, pm, kI, pm, m I Lbf, $\mathrm{kl} .[7 \mathrm{sts}$ ]
Set-up Row 2 (WS): K7.
Set-up Row 3 (RS): KI, mIR, k to m, mIL, slm, kI, slm, m|R,k to last st, mlL, kI. [l| sts]
Set-up Row 4 (WS): K5, pl, k5.
Set-up Row 5 (RS): KI, mlR, k to m, mIL, slm, kI, slm, mIR, k to last st, mIL, kI. [l| 5 sts]
Set-up Row 6 (WS): K5, p5, k5.

Work Rows I \& 2 of Stockinette Increase Pattern (see Stitch Guide) 45 times or until you have used up almost all 50 g of Color A (leaving enough for 2 more rows plus enough to weave in your end), whichever comes first. [195 sts]

Then work Row I once more. [199 sts]

Next row (WS): Knit.

## Change to Color B.

Work Rows I \& 2 of Stockinette Increase Pattern (see Stitch Guide) 20 times or until you have used up almost all 50 g of Color B (leaving enough for 2 more rows plus enough to weave in your end), whichever comes first. [279 sts]

Then work Row I once more. [283 sts]

Next row (WS): Knit.

## Change to Color C.

Work Rows I \& 2 of Stockinette Increase Pattern (see Stitch Guide) 16 times or until you have used up almost all 50 g of Color $C$ (leaving enough for 2 more rows plus enough to weave in your end), whichever comes first. [347 sts]

Then work Row I once more. [35 I sts]

Next row (WS): Knit.

Change to Color D.

Work Rows I \& 2 of Stockinette Increase Pattern (see Stitch Guide) 6 times. [375 sts]

Work Rows I \& 2 of Garter Increase Pattern (see Stitch Guide) 7 times or until you have used up almost all 50 g of Color $D$ (leaving enough to bind off and weave in your end), whichever comes first. [403 sts]

Bind off loosely knitwise.

## Finishing

Weave in ends and block to finished dimensions.
