

Pom Pom Necklace by amy Small

Pattern Note: This project involves no knitting and is super fast! It's the perfect way to use up your leftover yarn.

Materials:

Left over Knit Collage yarn - Gypsy Garden, Rolling Stone, Daisy Chain, Pixie Dust Mini & Sister all work well!

Sizes: One size fits all!

Pattern:

First use your leftover yarn to make 2 braids. The first braid should be approximately 32" long and 1/2" to 3/4" wide. On one end tie a double knot to create your clasp. On the other end, tie a knot and then create a loop about 1" long and wind the extra strands around your original knot. I stitched the wound yarn down to my knot to make sure the ends were secure. See detailed photo for reference.





Next create a shorter braid, 24" long and 1/2" to 3/4" wide. Create the clasp in the same way as you did on the first braid. Then, adorn with pom poms as you see fit! My mini pom poms are 1" in diameter and the larger pompom is 2" in diameter.
