

HAT

CO 96 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark start of rnd.

RNDS 1-5: *k2, p2, rep from * to end of rnd.

RND 6: k.

NEXT RND: Rep rnd 6 until piece meas 6½ (7)" from CO.

CROWN DECREASE

RND 1: *k2tog, k10, rep from * to end of rnd. (88 sts)

RND 2: k.

RND 3: *k2tog, k9, rep from * to end of rnd. (80 sts)

RND 4: k.

RND 5: *k2tog, k8, rep from * to end of rnd. (72 sts)

RND 6: k.

RND 7: *k2tog, k7, rep from * to end of rnd. (64 sts)

RND 8: *k2tog, k6, rep from * to end of rnd. (56 sts)

RND 9: *k2tog, k5, rep from * to end of rnd. (48 sts)

RND 10: *k2tog, k4, rep from * to end of rnd. (40 sts)

RND 11: *k2tog, k3, rep from * to end of rnd. (32 sts)

RND 12: *k2tog, k2, rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

RND 13: *k2tog, k1, rep from * to end of rnd. (16 sts)

RND 14: *k2tog, rep from * to end of rnd. (8 sts)

Cut yarn leaving 8" tail, thread through rem sts and pull to close.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block as desired.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel. Store your little treasure neatly folded, after all, it may be a family heirloom.

Knit in just one 50 gram hank of Woolstok, the Spicer Hat is a quick knit. With many color options, cast on and be done by the end of the day.

- Advanced Beginner

MATERIALS

- Woolstok (100% Fine Highland Wool; 50g/123yds): 1 hank
- Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needle, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Size 7 (4.5mm) double pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

SIZES

- Regular (Long)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Circumference: 19" (same for both) / Height: 8 (8½)"

GAUGE

- 20 sts and 30 rows = 4" in Stockinette stitch

ABBREVIATIONS

CO:	cast on
k:	knit
k2tog:	knit two together
meas:	measure
p:	purl
pm:	place marker
rem:	remaining
rep:	repeat
rnd:	round
st(s):	stitch(s)
*:	repeat the directions between the asterisks as many times as indicated

NOTES: Change to double-pointed needles when stitches no longer fit comfortably on circular needle.
