USA Hat & Cowl

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

HAT:

Circumference: 20½"

Height: 9¾"

COWL:

Circumference: 23¼"

Height: 8"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn *Uptown Bulky Amplify* (100% anti-pilling acrylic; 225g/197 yds)

• 908 World Cup – 1 ball

Needle: US Size 11 (8 mm) 16" circular, set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge

US Size 8 (5 mm) 16" circular

Notions: Tapestry needle, 2½" pom pom

maker

GAUGE

11 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st Save time, check your gauge.

HAT

With smaller circ ndl, cast on 48 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Brim

Rnds 1-9: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Hat Body

Switch to larger ndl.

Inc rnd: * K6, m1; rep from * to end – 56 sts.

Knit 17 rnds.

Crown Shaping

Switch to dpns when there are too few sts to fit on the circ ndl.

Rnd 1: K6, k2tog around – 49 stsrem

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3: K5, k2tog around – 42 stsrem

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5: K4, k2tog around – 35 sts rem.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: K3, k2tog around – 28 sts rem.

Rnd 8: K2, k2tog around – 21 sts rem.

Rnd 9: K1, k2tog around, 14 sts rem.

Rnd 10: K2tog around – 7 sts rem.

Break yarn leaving 6" tail. Pass tail through rem

live sts, pull taut, fasten off. Make pom-pom using

pom-pom maker. Sew to top of Hat.

COWL

With smaller circ ndl, cast on 64 sts. PM and join to work in the rnd.

Rnds 1-4: * K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Switch to larger ndl. Work even in St st until piece meas 6½". Switch to smaller ndl. Work 4 rnds of k2,

p2 ribbing. Bind off all sts in patt.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block.

Abbreviations

circ circular
dec('d) decrease(d)
inc('d) increase(d)

k knit

k2tog knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)

m marker

m1 insert left needle from front to back

under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back

loop (1 st inc'd)

meas measures
ndl needle
p purl

pm place marker
rem remain(ing)
rep repeat

rnd round st(s) stitch(es)

St st Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows,

purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit

every rnd)

tog together WS wrong side
